

# Rosé Wine

- 16. Torre Alta Pinot Grigio Rosé** **£15.50**  
**Italy**  
125ml Glass **£3.65**  
175ml Glass **£4.70**  
This wine shows why Rosé is so popular. Beautiful soft strawberry flavours with floral notes and a refreshing zing on the palate.

- 17. Domaine La Chautarde Rosé, Côteaux Varois En Provence South Of France** **£17.95**  
A light, dry and fruity rosé, with strawberry, red cherry flavours accompanying more subtle flavours of watermelon and nectarine. Soft acidity and delicate juiciness make for a refreshed palate.

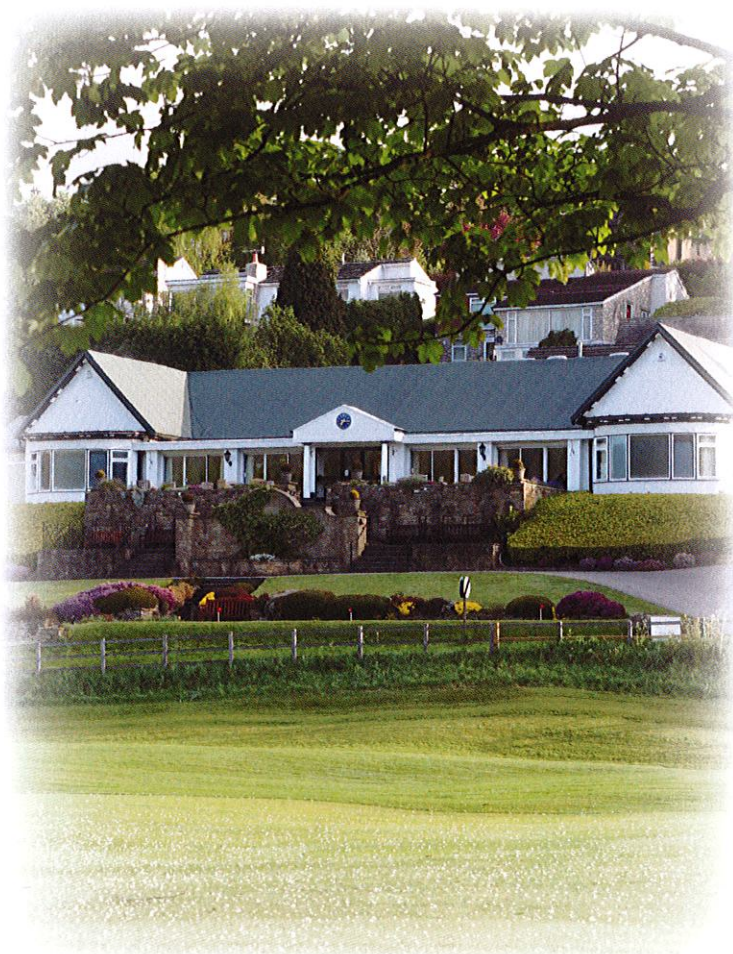


# Sparkling Wine

- 18. La Marca Prosecco (20cl Bottle)** **£6.95**  
**Italy**  
Pale and elegant, with a subtly perfumed bouquet, and youthful pear, melon and citrus fruit characters. Retains a little hint of sweetness which balances the crisp acidity and persistent fizz.

- 19. Prosecco Corte Alta NV, DOC, Italy** **£19.95**  
Delicate and aromatic with a light body and fine bubbles, this wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apricot and apple with a revitalising finish.

- 20. Nicolas Feuillatte NV, Champagne** **£32.95**  
A light, fresh and fruity Champagne with fine discreet bubbles and subtle overtones of apples, pears and citrus fruits. Has undergone a total of 4 years' ageing prior to release. Biscuity, toasty notes and fresh lemony fruit

# White Wine

- 1. Marques De Calado Macabeo** **£12.50**  
**Spain** 125ml Glass **£2.95**  
175ml Glass **£3.80**  
Fresh, floral aromas reminiscent of aromatic herbs, the smooth and velvety palate is fruit driven with citrus and tropical flavours.
- 2. Alfredini Garganega Pinot Grigio** **£14.95**  
**Italy** 125ml Glass **£3.50**  
175ml Glass **£4.55**  
Light in colour, refreshing, and crisp and with aromas of limes, grapefruits and lemons making this well balanced wine very easy to drink.
- 3. Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc** **£17.95**  
**New Zealand** 125ml Glass **£4.20**  
175ml Glass **£5.50**  
Very zesty on the palate with lots of lime and a nettly herbaceousness, this is an aromatic and classic New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc with a refreshing dry finish.
- 4. Picpoul Plo D'Isabelle** **£18.50**  
**Picpoul de Pinet**  
Youthfully pale lemon yellow, with a nose of lemon and lime fruit, and an intriguing blend of white blossom and green herb notes. Vibrant green apple fruit with a refreshingly dry and acidic finish.
- 5. Camino Real Blanco, Rioja** **£18.50**  
**Spain**  
Subtle flavours of cooked apple and peach. This wine has a generous creamy mouthfeel with a soft and polished finish.
- 6. Mâcon-Lugny, Louis Latour** **£19.95**  
**Burgundy**  
Pale gold in colour, with a beguiling aroma of fresh apples, lemon curd and toasted citrus fruits atop a palate of fresh and crisp green-apple acidity, buttery and peachy fruit and a long, warming finish.
- 7. Chablis Cape St Martin** **£24.50**  
**Burgundy**  
Hints of green apple and lime alongside ripe stone fruit and tropical aromas. A weightier palate than usual with medium levels of acidity and soft citrus flavours.

# Red Wine

- 8. El Molturo Tempranillo Garnacha** **£13.50**  
**Spain** 125ml Glass **£3.15**  
175ml Glass **£4.10**  
Aromas of ripe cherries and strawberries mingle with gentle pepper and spice. Smooth on the palate with easy going tannins which provide a ripe and friendly mouthfeel.
- 9. Five Foot Track Shiraz** **£15.50**  
**Australia** 125ml Glass **£3.65**  
175ml Glass **£4.70**  
A medium weight red, with a pleasing balance between ripe fruit and savoury, earthy notes on the nose. The palate is succulent and mouth-filling, with lashings of red berry and brambles.
- 10. Two Ridge Trail Merlot** **£16.50**  
**Australia** 125ml Glass **£3.85**  
175ml Glass **£5.00**  
An inviting nose of plum, earth and eucalyptus leads into a palate of blackberry and raspberry, with a supple texture and a satisfying fruit sweetness.
- 11. Château de Pizay, Morgon** **£18.95**  
**Beaujolais Cru**  
This top class wine has a nose dominated by blackberries and cherries and a silky smooth palate with fine tannins combining. Classic Morgon, showing the fruit of Beaujolais and the charm of Burgundy.
- 12. Chianti Poggio Galiga, Grati** **£18.95**  
**Italy**  
This is a very traditional style of Chianti. Full of red cherry flavours and violets, with vibrant acidity, hints of sweet spices and a beautiful long, silky finish.
- 13. Capillo de Barro Malbec** **£19.50**  
**Argentina**  
An intense nose of plum and bramble. Fulsome on the palate, delivering a wave of ripe, fresh black fruit and mocha.
- 14. Rioja Reserva, Cune CVNE** **£19.95**  
**Spain**  
A soft luxurious wine, mid garnet in colour with a lovely brambly nose and a hint of spice. Nuances of warm leather, caramel and coffee over rich autumn fruit. Excellent balance and a lingering finish.
- 15. Château Caronne St Gemme** **£27.50**  
**Bordeaux**  
A bright nose of red fruit with a perfumed edge follows onto the palate with added nuances of smoke, black pepper and subtle oak.
